Preparing a physical host for installation

{avatar_b}™ {edition_name} software is designed to be installed on physical hosts that have been configured as follows.

For **all** machines (other than the {avatar_c}-server) that are part of the {avatar_b}TM {edition_name} network, do the following.

- 1. Install an operating system on the physical host.
- 2. Use Ubuntu server version 12.04.1 (Precise Pangolin) available on the internet.
- 3. Configure the machine to use dhcp to acquire an IP address.

For machines designated as **servers**, additionally do the following.

- 1. Install a virtualization platform.
- 2. Download VMware (version 1.0.9) packages from the internet.
- 3. Follow the installation instructions provided therein.
