Workspace Management: How does one shutdown servers and {avatar_c} server?

- Login as administrator and check for pending jobs by going to Workspace->Jobs->'All pending jobs'.
- If there are no pending jobs,
 - shutdown all servers by navigating to **Workspace->Servers**, selecting all servers, and clicking on **'More action**'->'**Power off**'.
 - Shutting down a managed host with pending job is not allowed. However, one could first delete pending jobs before shutting down the host ..
- After shutting down servers, one can shutdown the {avatar_c}-server by issuing the command "sudo poweroff" from the console. If the {avatar_c}-server is also a server, care must be taken to ensure that the server is the last host to be shutdown.
